If you have already completed EDUC7027, it still counts towards your program and you simply complete the other three listed courses (EDUC7000+EDUC7001+EDUC7002).

If you haven't already completed EDUC7027, you instead complete EDUC7230 Working with Students with Challenging Behaviours, offered in semester 2 2015.

If you **must** graduate at the end of semester 1, you may still apply to complete EDUC7027 – please include details of why you must graduate in July when you submit the [Project Application Form](#).

For those students completing more than one Field of Study:

If you have declared* both Behaviour Management **and** Inclusive and Special Needs (you will receive a similar email regarding the I&SN Field as well), EDUC7002 is common to both Fields but can only be counted once. To graduate with both Fields, your completion plan is different to someone who is only completing Behaviour Management alone:

If all of the Field/s you wish to add are not available to you on mySI-net, please email education@uq.edu.au with your name, student number and the Field/s you wish to add.

Please ensure that you enrol in all your chosen courses prior to Week 1 to allow for this check to be completed as soon as possible.
